

GCCC Allied Health Program TB Infection Control Plan

Upon enrollment into Allied Health courses for Certified Nurse Aide or Certified Medication Aide, incoming students must provide a complete Health Certificate, no older than one year prior to the start date of the course, as evidence of the following:

1. One-Step Mantoux – *Tine test is not acceptable* (Chest X-ray if Positive).
2. If a chest radiograph (X-ray) has been completed within the past 5 years with a negative report, students must provide a copy of the X-ray report and a completed TB risk assessment signed by a health care professional.
