ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

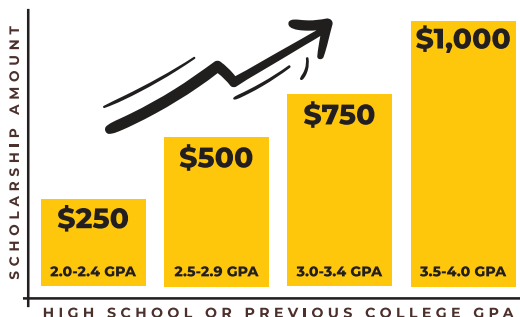
Awards are based on high school or college GPA. It pays to have good grades! LITERALLY!

APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Available October 1 - June 30 each year.

FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID - FAFSA

Federal Pell grants and Federal loans are available to eligible students.

FEDERAL PELL GRANTS

Do not have to be repaid and range in size according to student eligibility and the student's level of enrollment.

SUBSIDIZED & UNSUBSIDIZED FEDERAL LOANS

Have to be repaid once the student completes their degree or certificate or if the student drops out.
